Virginia Medicaid members and their caregivers can get their 1st, 2nd, 3rd or booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine at the Endependence Center in Norfolk. Please sign up today!

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Every Medicaid member over the age of 5
- Caregivers, including family members and personal care attendants
- Health care providers
- Medicaid members needing a booster dose
 - Pfizer boosters are now recommended for everyone over 16 years old

WHAT VACCINES WILL BE OFFERED?

- Pfizer for individuals 12 years and older
- Pfizer for individuals aged 5 to 11 years old
